Michael Bryne was my great grandfather. I am a descendant of his second marriage.

In this document and the accompanying diagrams, each person has an assigned ID. The ID is a segmented number where each segment is separated by a period. The number of segments indicates the generation. For example, 1.3.3 is the third child of 1.3 who is the second child of 1.0. Spouses are identified with a suffix of “-*n*” where *n* is the number of the marriage; for example, 1.3.3-1 is the first spouse of 1.3.3.

Key dates are specified in MM-DD-CCYY format with abbreviations:

Kip Ford reports he had five wives, but Michael only lived three more years after his divorce from wife #2. When the Pamet River silted up so a boat could no longer get up it, he moved the house to Bound Brook Island, Wellfleet, MA by cutting it in half and moving each half on a wagon.</p> <p>In 1880 lived in Wellfleet with wife Cara (Caroline apparently has several nicknames) and 8 children Andrew W., Thomas H., Willard B., George M., James W., Estella D, John D., and Alma M.</p> <p>In 1885 he lived with son William H. Bryne in Keyport, NJ. He died the next year in Jersey City, NJ and was originally buried in NJ.</p>

			<p>Died of yellow fever or “one of those things” (per John D. BRYNE).</p> <p>In the 1870 census Michael claimed to be a US citizen. On 5-28-2020 I found a naturalization record that is undoubtedly his. It gives his full birthdate and location, and the date he arrived USA.</p>

In 1900 lived in Raritan, NJ at 306 Howard Street with wife Emma and 4 children: Geneva (10, b. 12-1898 NJ), Telfair (6, b. 2-1894 NJ), William (23, b. 6-1872 NJ, married 5 years, oysterman), and Edward (13, b. 3-1887 NJ); oysterman. Nearby lived one Poling family, three Walling families, and one VanPelt family. In 1910 lived in Keyport, NJ on Manchester Avenue with wife and son Telfair; foreman oysterhouse. In 1920 lived in Keyport, NJ with wife Emma; foreman oysterhouse.</p> <p>There were a number of Bryne families in Monmouth County, NJ in this time frame for which I can find no relationships. In 1880 there were 21 Brynes: 3 families living in Millstone (16 people, heads all born Ireland, children all born NJ) and 1 family living in Raritan (5 people, headed by William H. Bryne). These two towns are some distance apart, maybe 40 miles. That Michael Bryne's first son would move to NJ suggests he knew the men from Ireland. The Monmouth County 1875 census has no Brynes. At her death she left six grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.</p> <p>Emma’s mother’s obituary in the Red Bank Register 2-26-1902: Mrs. Adeline (Mason) Poling of Keyport died on Tuesday of last week. Her death was caused by typhoid pneumonia, and she had been sick only five days. The was 73 years old and had lived at Keyport since she was twenty years old. For forty years she had been a member of the Keyport Methodist church. Her husband, William Poling, survives her, and she also leaves three daughters and four sons. The children are Samuel, William A., Britton and Thomas Poling; Adaline, wife of Furman Smith; Emma, wife of William H. Bryne; and Mary, wife of Harry Alberts. Mrs. Poling also leaves 36 grandchildren. She was a sister of Wesley Mason, who lives between Keyport and Holmdel.</p>

Bryne (3, b. 2-1897 NJ), daughter Stillian Bryne (9/12, b. 8-1899 NJ); married 4 years, 2 children born, 2 living, clammer. There is something odd about the youngest child, a girl born 8-1899. Given the birth date for Stillman (9-9-1900) and that the 1910 census reported 3 children born, 2 living, it may be that the third child was Stillman and that the daughter died before Stillman's death. So, that is how I will write it here.</p> <p>I suspect he was dead by 1906 because (1) his wife remarried then and (2) his son Charles reported his mother as his nearest relative in 1917.</p>

NJ); she was named Steenie Monahan, age 30, married 4 years, had 3 children, 2 living.</p> <p>James Monahan lived in 1900 in Elizabeth, NJ (age 22, single, b. 2-1878 NJ, parents b. Fleischman: His 1918 draft record is for William Paul Fleischman, age 37, born 7-26-1881, living in Elizabeth, NJ with Sallie Fleischman, working as core maker for Moore Bros. Elizabeth. His 1942 draft record is a confirmation: William Paul Fleischman, age 60, born 7-26-1881 NYC, living on Liddy Street, Keansburg, NJ with Steenie Fleischman, unemployed.</p> <p>Thursday 3-27-1947 Red Bank Register had her obituary. She was a life-long resident of Keansburg. Was survived by her husband William P. Fleischman, son Stillman Byrne [sic] of Keansburg, and a sister Mrs. Rose Vanderbilt of New Brunswick. Funeral was at Keansburg Methodist Church, burial at Green Grove Cemetery.</p>

NY, age 24 at first marriage), wife Steenie Fleischman (49, b. NJ, age 18 at first marriage) as step-son, age 26. Note that the ages were overwritten on the census page. In 1940 lived in East Keansburg, Monmouth Co., NJ on Williams Avenue with mother Steenie Fleischman (60) and step-father James Fleischman (60). Stillman (39) was a laborer on road construction, single, completed 5th grade. Fleischman (60) was born NY and a roofing tinsmith (?).

So perhaps it was really "Welch." Her obituary in the 3-19-1902 Red Bank Register: Mrs. Mary Etta (Byrne) Welch, daughter of Emma and William Bryne of Keyport died on Friday, aged 22 years. She was a member of the Degree of Pocahontas lodge of Keyport.
