In this document and the accompanying diagrams, each person has an assigned ID. The ID is a segmented number where each segment is separated by a period. The number of segments indicates the generation. For example, 1.3.3 is the third child of 1.3 who is the second child of 1.0. Spouses are identified with a suffix of “-n” where n is the number of the marriage; for example, 1.3.3-1 is the first spouse of 1.3.3.

When the Pamet River silted up so a boat could no longer get up it, he moved the house to Bound Brook Island, Wellfleet, MA by cutting it in half and moving each half on a wagon.</p> <p>In 1880 lived in Wellfleet with wife Cara (Caroline apparently has several nicknames) and 8 children Andrew W., Thomas H., Willard B., George M., James W., Estella D, John D., and Alma M.</p> <p>Died of yellow fever or “one of those things” (per John D. BRYNE).</p>

In 1845 brother Obadiah Sumner BROWN married Hannah Collins PAINE in Truro, MA. It appears her parental family moved to Truro before her marriage to Michael Bryne. Marietta was married by A. H. Newton, M. E. Preacher. In 1850 lived Mercer, ME with parental family. In 1860 lived in Truro with husband and 3 children.

In 1895 lived in Raritan, NJ with wife Emma and children William H., Charles S., Mary E., Adaline, Daniel E. Geneva, and Telfair. In 1900 lived in Raritan, NJ on Howard Street with wife and 4 children: Geneva, Telfair, William, and Edward; oysterman. In 1910 lived in Keyport, NJ on Manchester Avenue with wife and son Telfair; foreman oysterhouse. In 1920 lived in Keyport, NJ with wife Emma; foreman oysterhouse.</p> <p>There were a number of Bryne families in Monmouth County, NJ in this time frame for which I can find no relationships. In 1880 there were 21 Brynes: 3 families living in Millstone (16 people, heads all born Ireland, children all born NJ) and 1 family living in Raritan (5 people, headed by William H. Bryne). These two towns are some distance apart, maybe 40 miles. That Michael Bryne's first son would move to NJ suggests he knew the men from Ireland. The Monmouth County 1875 census has no Brynes. Seven siblings in 1870. Had 7 children, only 6 living by 1910. In 1860 lived in Raritan with parental family. In 1870 lived in Keyport in Raritan with parental family. In 1930 lived as widow in Keyport, NJ near to a Walling family (her daughter Adaline married a Walling). She died in the home of her daughter Adaline. At her death she left six grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.

Bryne of Keyport, was not hurt by a fire per the 10-29-1930 Red Bank Register. This must be the son of 1.1.2.1, previously unknown. In 1930 lived in Middletown (East Keansburg), NJ on Van Brunt Place with William P. Fleischman (49, b. NY), Steenie (49, b. NJ) as step-son.

Green Grove Cemetery, Keyport, NJ	<p>6-2-2010: An obituary appeared in the 10-25-1965 issue of The Daily Register of Red Bank, NJ for Mrs. Addie B. Walling, 83 who died 10-22-1965. She was the “daughter of the late William Bryne and Mrs. Emma Poling Bryne.” She was survived by her husband George I. Walling, two sons, two daughters, two brothers—Edward Bryne of Keyport and Telfair Bryne of Belford— and 11 grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren. So now I know more about Emma’s name. But which child is Addie? Surely that is a nickname. There were only two daughters: Marietta and Geneva. But Addie was born in 1965 – 83 = 1882, so she must be new to me. I subsequently found a burial record that gave her name as Adaline. A new Bryne! In 1920 lived in Keyport, NJ on Maple Place with wife Susella (22, b. NJ, parents b. NJ); machinist in aeroplane plant. Could not find in 1930 census. In 1942 lived in Belford, NJ; worked for Ehret & Day at Camp Vail, NJ; wife not mentioned. In 1955 lived in Belford, NJ. In 1965 lived in Keyport, NJ.

Clarissa's parents were Joshua and Sarah H. Atwood. Mother: Eureka K. PARSONS, born July 1860 Truro, MA, married 1882 MA, died between 1920 and 1930 likely in Loudon, NH. Siblings: Estella May Smith, Lucy Grove Smith, and Rolfe Paine Smith. Rolfe married Elbren's sister Maria Sumner Bryne in 1908, not quite a dual wedding, but close. She and Elbren lived in North Truro at the time of their marriage. In 1930 lived in Chittenden, VT at 83 Lake View Terrace with daughters and son; worked as burler in woolen mill. Died of cerebral thrombosis.
