In this document and the accompanying diagrams, each person has an assigned ID. The ID is a segmented number where each segment is separated by a period. The number of segments indicates the generation. For example, 1.2.3 is the third child of 1.2 who is the second child of 1.0. Spouses are identified with a suffix of "-*n*" where *n* is the number of the marriage; for example, 1.2.3-1 is the first spouse of 1.2.3.

George won the bid and contracted on 7-6-1951; he was paid \$227,000 and given title to the ship and its contents. It took him to June 1952 to raise the ship, during which he spent much more than he had been paid.
