In this document and the accompanying diagrams, each person has an assigned ID. The ID is a segmented number where each segment is separated by a period. The number of segments indicates the generation. For example, 1.2.3 is the third child of 1.2 who is the second child of 1.0. Spouses are identified with a suffix of “-*n*” where *n* is the number of the marriage; for example, 1.2.3-1 is the first spouse of 1.2.3.

Key dates are specified in MM-DD-CCYY format with abbreviations:

BROWN in Truro, MA  m2. 1861 Caroline Ann DOREY in Truro, MA  div2. 12-5-1882 Barnstable, MA  d. 1885  bur. originally Passaic, NJ; moved to Pleasant Hill Cemetery, Wellfleet, MA</p>	<p>Parents: Michael and Ann BRYNE [per record of marriage with Caroline, surname written Brien]. The 1930 census reports Estella Bryne's father was born in Northern Ireland. This is the only detail so far.  Was a sea captain.  With Caroline DOREY owned a house in Truro, MA.  When the Pamet River silted up so a boat could no longer get up it, he moved the house to Bound Brook Island, Wellfleet, MA by cutting it in half and moving each half on a wagon.  Kip Ford reports he had five wives, but Michael only lived three more years after his divorce from wife #2.  Marriage record to Caroline Dorey says his occupation was "mariner". In 1880 census his occupation was "laborer".  In 6-26-1860 lived in Truro, MA with wife Mary and 3 children William (age 8, born about 1852), Maria (age 5), and Michael (age 4).  In 1870 lived in Truro, MA with wife Caroline and 7 children William H., Maria S., Lewis, Andrew W., Thomas H., Willard B., George M.  In 1880 lived in Wellfleet with wife Cara (Caroline apparently has several nicknames) and 8 children Andrew W., Thomas H., Willard B., George M., James W., Estella D, John D., and Alma M.  Died of yellow fever or "one of those things" (per John D. BRYNE).</p>

In 1845 brother Obadiah Sumner BROWN married Hannah Collins PAINE in Truro, MA.  It appears her parental family moved to Truro before her marriage to Michael Bryne.  Marietta was married by A. H. Newton, M. E. Preacher.  In 1850 lived Mercer, ME with parental family.  In 1860 lived in Truro with husband and 3 children.</p>

In 1900 lived in Truro, MA with wife Mary A. and children Elbren L., Maria S., Mary H., and Cora L; trap fisherman. In 1920 lived in owned home on County Road in Truro, MA with wife Mary A., son Lester P. (age 14), and son Leighton W. (age 10); trap fisherman. In 1930 lived in Burlington, VT with Mary (age 53), daughter-in-law Hannah and her children, daughter Cora, son Lester and his family, and son Leighton. Michael was a laborer in the building trade, Cora was a restaurant waitress, Leighton was a clothing machine stitcher.

In 1920 lived in rented home at 103 Barfold (?) Street, Burlington City, VT; was foreman in state garage.

She and Elbren lived in North Truro at the time of their marriage. In 1930 lived in Chittenden, VT at 83 Lake View Terrace with daughters and son; worked as burler in woolen mill.

Irma D. and Ruth A.), nephew Kenneth Lewis BRYNE, parents-in-law, and grandmother-in-law Lucy PARSONS; husband and father were farmers. Margaret was a descendant of William Logan  Leete, the first governor of CT.  Baptized by Charles I. Shreve. Caroline was living in  Arichat, Nova Scotia at the time of her marriage to Michael  Bryne.  Caroline was a friend of Michael Bryne’s first wife. After  her death, he visited Caroline in Nova Scotia to ask her to  take care of the children. They subsequently married.  Married by A. H. Newton, M. E. Preacher.  Caroline divorced Michael for “extreme cruelty” beginning  January 1879.  Remarried 5-14-1887 Henry KING in Brockton, MA; this  was a second marriage for each. His parents were George  and Lydia King. He was born in Barnstable, MA about  1843 and was a mariner. He lived in Wellfleet in 1870 (age  29) and 1880 (age 38) with wife Sabra, son William H., and  son Irving A.; born about 1841.  Caroline died of cancer in Medford, MA (presumably a  hospital).  Headstone reads “Caroline Ann Doré”.  Miscellaneous items about second husband Henry King:  Henry participated in a deed for Truro property in 9-1919.  Irving A. King, 19, of Wellfleet married Bessie Hughes, 21,  Truro on 12-6-1888.</p>

Bryne & Son Construction which built water lines and sewer lines; the son was Thomas Lachlyn Bryne. The business stopped at his death. One project was to dismantle the drawbridge over the Cape Cod Canal. He worked on the Boston subway and metropolitan sewer. Went to WY to mine. In 1900 lived in Carbon County, WY with wife Rose and son Thomas. In 1910 lived in Boston, MA with wife Rose; they had been married 11 years with 2 children, 1 living; general contractor. In 1920 lived in Hartford, CT with son Thomas L.; both general contractors. In 1924 was a city officer of Hartford, CT. In 1930 lived in Hartford, CT on Linnmore Street with wife Clara, sister-in-law Hellen A. COE, age 40, and maid; road contractor. Parker family lived next door. Died of kidney failure.

Immigrated in 1870. In 1892 lived in Somerville, MA at 27 Thurston with Edwin H. Barrett. Lived in Somerville at the time of her marriage. Name on marriage record is "Annie E. Barrett." In 1900 lived in Medford, MA on Vernon Street as married woman (married 15 years) with children William W., John F., Annie L., Mary C., Andrew M. Had 6 children, 5 living [the dead child would have been Andrew Vincent]. In 1910 lived in Somerville, MA with her children. In 1920 lived in Manhattan, NY on West 80th St., a widow, with daughter Anna.

I have not been able to substantiate it.] Parents born in Canada (English-speaking). Son Thomas Lachlyn Bryne believed her to be related to Julia T. (Dorey) MULLINS, but this has yet to be proved. He also said her father was a French cavalry officer. May have been from Nova Scotia. Attended school in CA. Thought to have attended Mills College in Oakland, CA on 1-12-1888 and that Asa HAMILTON, married to Eunice Lucretia Louisa Jane DOREY, paid her tuition. Leander Dorey was unable to confirm the attendance with the college. In 1900 lived in Carbon County, WY with husband and son Thomas. A horsewoman, she never recovered from a fall. She drowned herself. There is a dress of hers in a museum in Cheyenne, WY.

Jr. (born 10-8-1873), Phillip A. (born about 1874), Bessie (born about 1877), Helen A. (born 6-1886). In 1870 lived in Meriden, CT with parents, servant, and gardener. In 1880 lived in Meriden with parents, Winfield R. Jr., Phillip A., and Bessie . In 1900 lived in Meriden, CT with parents, Winfield Jr., and Helen A.; brother Winfield was a paymaster assistant, Clara was an elocutionist. In 1920 lived in Hartford, CT with sister Helen; teacher. In 1920 brother Winfield lived in Meriden, CT with wife Emma (age 45, parents from Ireland) and daughters Mary E. (age 11) and Frances (age 7); paymaster for silver company. Winfield died 8-1964 in CT. Was an elocution teacher and active in the Women's Temperance movement. Died of kidney failure.

At death had 4 grandchildren and 4 great-grandchildren. May have died of heart problem. Ensign-Bickford Company began in 1836 in Simsbury, CT and manufactures blasting products.
