This is the ancestry of Mary Elizabeth Gunning who married John James Dorey, my great-grandfather. The Gunnings immigrated from Ireland and settled in the Jamaica Plain area of Boston, MA.

# **Timothy Gunning and Margaret Greeley**

This couple was named on a document of their son. They are believed not to have immigrated to the USA.

Their relationship to the following has not been verified. But the connection to Horton House and Winterbottom is titillating because of my Clirchugh family connection to Winterbottom (George Harold Winterbottom, who bought Horton House, was the brother of a man who married the first cousin of my great-grandfather).

The earliest-known person in this family is Timothy Gunning, believed to have been born in 1818 in the civil Parish of Moore, County Roscommon, Ireland; his parents are believed to have been Timothy Gunning and Margaret Greeley, both of whom remained in Ireland. There were a number of Gunning families in county Roscommon between 1848 and 1864 (23 were enumerated in Griffith's Valuation). I have found no way to analyze their family relationships.

There was a Gunning family that produced Sir Robert Gunning (1731-1816), who was made Knight Companion of the Order of the Bath (KB) in 1773 and a baronet in 1778. He bought Horton House in 1781, and is thus connected to my Winterbottom family (who acquired the estate in 1899). There is no evidence that this family, which originated in Kent and moved to county Roscommon in the early 1600s, had any male descendants who might have lived in Roscommon in 1818.

# Timothy Gunning (1818–1893) and Margaret Donnelly (1825–1897)

Timothy Gunning was born August 12, 1818 in the civil Parish of Moore, County Roscommon, Ireland. He immigrated to MA, arriving in New York City on the ship *Garrick* on June 1, 1846, age 25; he was naturalized Jan 1, 1855, when he lived in Roxbury. Also on the *Garrick* was Elizabeth Gunning, age 24, who may have been Timothy's sister.

Margaret was born 1825 Ireland. She and Timothy were likely married in Ireland as their first child was born there. She died April 7, 1897 of La Grippe/pneumonia at 226 Lamartine, Roxbury and was buried April 9, 1897 in Mt. Calvary Cemetery, Roslindale; her age was cited as 72. She was described as the widow of Timothy "men" Donovan, father was Michael, mother Mary Kelley. This suggests her father was Michael Donovan; the Massachusetts Vital Record Index cites her death as Margaret (Donovan) Gunning. Her son John's marriage record named her as Donnelly.

A handwritten Layman family document names Timothy's wife as Margaret Greeley. This may have been a generational error.

He is likely the man who was buried in Mt. Calvary Cemetery on Dec 20, 1893; his age is given as 68 which gives a birth year of 1825. He lived at 228 Lamartine Street, Jamaica Plain at time of death.

I found other spellings in later census, which although I could not tie them to this child definitely, suggested his name was spelled differently. This may be the person who was naturalized on 11-21-1887 with birth year 1843 in Ireland, address in Boston, name spelled "Karen."
- ii. Patrick Gunning, born 1847 in Boston and died Dec 20, 1848 from whooping cough, age 1 year.
- Iii. Timothy Joseph Gunning, born April 9, 1849 MA. He married Maria J. Carney and is detailed below.
- iv. John B. Gunning, born Nov 12, 1852 Roxbury, MA. He married Ellen J. Goode on Feb 12, 1877 in Brookline, MA. This couple is detailed below.

# Timothy Joseph Gunning (1849–1927) and Maria J. Carney (1850–1919)

Timothy Joseph Gunning was born April 9, 1849 MA. Timothy died May 29, 1927 and was buried in Mt. Calvary Cemetery, Roslindale.

He married Maria J. Carney on Sept 10, 1868 in Boston, MA by Rev. J. Healey; first marriage for both, he a carpenter born Roxbury, she born Ireland. She was born May 1850 Ireland and died 1919, her father was William Carney. She died of endometrial carcinoma. Maria was buried in Mt. Calvary Cemetery on Dec 2, 1919; at the time of her death she lived at 4507 Washington Street, Roslindale.

In 1883–4 Timothy was paid by the City of Boston \$1260.50 for sewer work. The next entry on page 263 of the City's Annual Report of Receipts and Expenditures is for J J Dorey paid \$953.56. [That would be my great grandfather John James Dorey.]

# Timothy William Gunning (1874–1918) and Grace Ellen Morrison (1882–)

Timothy William Gunning was born June 13, 1874 Roxbury, MA. He died Oct 3, 1918 MA of influenza, he was buried Oct 5, 1918 in grave 13, range 83, section 6 of Mt. Calvary Cemetery.<sup>3</sup> At his death he lived 57 Germania Street, Jamaica Plain (Germania is near Washington Street).

He married Grace Ellen Morrison in 1901 Boston. She was born Aug 7, 1882 Boston, MA. Her parents were Nathan F. and Mary L. (Dutton) Morrison. In 1900 Grace and her parental family lived in Boston on Wachussett Street with a number of Gunnings who were in-laws, sister Sarah Morrison married Stephen J. Gunning.

After Timothy's death Grace remarried at age 42 Edward Condon, a railroad worker, and moved to Hartford, CT. She is buried at Forest Hills Cemetery, Boston, MA.

His 1918 draft card cited him living at 37 Germania, West Roxbury with Grace E. Gunning. He was a school house janitor for the City of Boston. The 1918 Manual of the Public Schools of the City of Boston cited him as janitor at Florence Street School, 163 Bellevue Ave., Roslindale.

i. William Joseph Gunning, born Jul 27, 1902 at 9 Conway Street, Boston, MA where parents lived. Died Mar 28, 1986 Miami, FL.

Son William Joseph Gunning married about 1922 or 1923 and later divorced. He had two children:

### John B. Gunning (1852–1936) and Ellen Josephine Goode (1849–1932)

John B. Gunning was born Nov 12, 1852 Roxbury, MA. He married Ellen Josephine Goode on Feb 12, 1877 in Brookline, MA at St. Mary's Church by L. J. Morris, she lived in Brookline; the marriage record cited his mother as Margaret Donnelly. There is a second marriage record for this couple recorded at Boston for Dec. 12, 1878, they both lived Roxbury; married by Thomas McGinnis, Boston.

Ellen Goode was born May 1849 Roxbury, MA. Her parents were John and Ellen Goode, both born Ireland. John Gunning died in February 1936 at age 83, Ellen Gunning died in January 1932 at age 82. [These death dates were provided by the cemetery and appear on their tombstone, they need to be confirmed with the civic records.]

John, Ellen, and their daughter Mary are buried in St Joseph's Cemetery, West Roxbury, MA.

### Mary Elizabeth Gunning (1879–1914) and John James Dorey (1844–1923)

Mary Elizabeth Gunning, known as Minnie, was born Aug 25, 1879 in Boston, MA on Lamartine Street. She married John James Dorey on Aug 9, 1905 in Boston when she was 26 and he 60. She died July 1914 (age 34) and is buried in St. Joseph's Cemetery in Roxbury, MA.

John James Dorey was born Jan 1844 Arichat, Nova Scotia. His first wife had died Feb 22, 1905 in Somerville, MA of ptomaine poisoning. John's details and ancestry are detailed in the family of his father Philip Cyrus Dorey.

I have found no information on Mary after 1910. I found only Mary in the 1910 census, John was in Arichat visiting family. John married a third time, in November 1914 Elizabeth T. (Reynolds) Beals, that marriage ended in divorce. John married a fourth time, in 1920 Sarah Elizabeth (Hensley) McDonald, a widow who survived him. John died in 1923 at Denver, Colorado and is buried in Fairmount Cemetery there.

# Jamaica Plain

Jamaica Plain is an historic neighborhood of 4.4 square miles in Boston, Massachusetts. Founded by Boston Puritans seeking farm land to the south, it was originally part of the city of Roxbury. The community seceded from Roxbury as a part of the new town of West Roxbury in 1851, and became part of Boston when West Roxbury was annexed to Boston in 1874.
