

## THE DOREY FAMILY

George Dorey the First came from the Isle of Jersey, one of the Channel Islands between England and France. His first wife went into shock during childbirth when she heard her husband had gotten into an accident. The baby girl survived and married a Dixon. George Dorey the First survived the accident and married a young nurse who also died when a son was born to them. The son, George Dorey 2nd, became very wealthy and lived in luxurious surroundings.

George 2nd married a woman from the LaSalir family. They had three sons, Phillip and George were doctors and Henry was a sea captain. Jane, their daughter, married Charles Frederick Latimer.

The four children; Jane, Henry, Phillip, and George 3rd all migrated to Canada with the Janvrin's family when they brought some settlers over to establish a fishing industry. All lived and married there. Jane had nine children, Mr. Latimer died in 1838 and she remarried Donald MacPherson and had one more child. Phillip had five children while married to Margaret Leet then remarried Hattie Franklin. Both Jane and Phillip are buried at the St. John's Anglican graveyard in Arichat.

A stained glass window in memory of Captain Henry Dorey is in the same church. It is believed he was married in New York.

George Dorey 3rd settled in Janvrin's Island and married Christian Cameron. His second marriage was to Charlotte Pettipas, daughter of Louis Pettipas and Charlotte Bellfontaine of Tracadie. They had four children; George William (1848-1904), who married Judith Angele Ranson, daughter of Charles Ranson and Marine Bonin of D'Escousse, they lived in Benny Dorey's house. Clement Henry (1851- ) married Adele Landry (1854-1954), daughter of Charles Landry and Virginia Boudreau. Their home was Miller Dorey's house, now owned by Pauline Cave. Peter Dorey (1855- ) married Marie Emille Eugene Morin (1858-1897), daughter of Augustine Morin and Sophie Chenalle. They lived in the house that Betty Peterson now owns. The last child, Anne, was born in 1857. There is no record of any marriage or children for Anne. We are not sure if she died young or just never married.

Lived to be 109 years old.

George William 4th married Judith Angele Ranson. She died at Janvrin's Island at age 109. They had six children: Marie Jane married Desire Grey; Angelique Anne died at 13; Louise Artimise married a Ranson; Charles; William; Peter John (1875- ) married Marie Bertha DeCoste (1886- ). George William died at the age of 100 years in the house that was built before the house Benny now lives in. This was the old Dorey residence. Judith Angelique died at age 109 in the house Benny now lives in. When they first married the family moved to the United States and lived in Rhode Island for 20 years before they moved back to Janvrin's. Three of their children stayed on in the United States. Louise married a Ranson and moved to Arichat, that is where she died. Peter John moved back to Janvrin's Island

Peter John and Marie Bertha lived on Janvrin's Island in the family home. They had 13 children: Peter Wilfred(Fred); Marie Alice; William John; Marie Margaret Lorraine; Corrine; Louise Melvina; Joseph Elic (Lee) and

Fred married Joline Landry and they had six children, they live in River Bourgeois. Their oldest, Everett is married and lives in Ontario. Roddy married Margaret Owen and they live in Sydney. My father was born and grew up on the old homestead along with six brothers and nine sisters. Papa and Nanny are laid to rest with the Lord now and we all know they are in good hands along with Aunt Theresa and Aunt Helen. When Papa passed on he left a piece of land to my Dad, who took advantage of it and built a beautiful summer home. I have a feeling some day he will move back to where he feels most at home.
